AUTUMN LAWN FEED

Now is the time to apply Autumn lawn feed. We have a good stock in the shed selling at £3 for 3kg bag (enough for 80 square metres.)

SHED

We now stock Perlite and Vermiculite in the shed at prices much cheaper than in the shops. These products are effective in improving drainage and aeration in compost especially when taking cuttings or seed sowing.

We still have a few bags of this season's compost at only £4.80 for 75 litres. Most garden centres charge more than this for only 50 litre bags. Get your bags now before the winter season.

As we are coming to the end of the growing season, Our last regular opening of the shed was on Sunday August 20th. But members can still buy items from the shed during the autumn & winter months.
