Have you been to the shed this season to spend your discount voucher?

We have introduced several new products in the shed this season:

Provado Fruit & Veg Bug Killer- a pesticide for fruit and vegetables

Copper mixture- a mineral supplement which may also help reduce the impact of blight and mildews

Moisture control gel - granules to add to compost to help retain water. Very good for hanging baskets

Mycorrhizal fungi (sold out) Fungi which help roots absorb nutrients from the soil, especially used when planting shrubs

Smaller (40 litre) bags of compost
